28 Days of Prayer from Pentecost to HOPE18

As we celebrate the outpouring of the Holy Spirit on God's people at Pentecost so we look forward to seeing Jesus made known to our community through New Milton HOPE18 weekend in 4 weeks time. When Jesus looked at the crowds before Him, His desire was to see them find the hope that is only found in Him.

Matthew 9:36-38

“When Jesus saw the crowds, he had compassion on them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd. Then he said to his disciples, “The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field.”

As his disciples we have been appointed to bear fruit and our desire is that we should see a harvest from all our activities over HOPE weekend. As we, the church in New Milton, prepare for this weekend let us join together in prayer to see His Kingdom come and His will be done in our communities.

This prayer guide provides a focus and a bible verse to pray each day. Let's pray believing that God will move in power over HOPE18 weekend.

John 17:15-16

“I no longer call you servants, because a servant does not know his master's business. Instead, I have called you friends, for everything that I learned from my Father I have made known to you. You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you so that you might go and bear fruit—fruit that will last—and so that whatever you ask in my name the Father will give you.”

Week 1 21st-27th May: Praying for the church in New Milton

Monday 21st May

Pray for revelation of Jesus' beauty that we might walk in our calling and destiny by God's power

Ephesians 1:17-19 ... asking that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the glorious Father, may give you the Spirit of wisdom and revelation, so that you may know him better. I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened in order that you may know the hope to which he has called you, the riches of his glorious inheritance in his holy people, and his incomparably great power for us who believe.

Tuesday 22nd May

Pray to receive the Spirit's power so that Jesus' presence would be manifest in us

Ephesians 3:16,17 ...pray that out of his glorious riches he may strengthen you with power through his Spirit in your inner being, so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith.

Wednesday 23rd May

Pray to know God's will and to be fruitful in ministry and strengthened by intimacy with Him

Colossians 1:9-11 ...ask God to fill you with the knowledge of his will through all the wisdom and understanding that the Spirit gives, so that you may live a life worthy of the Lord and please him in every way: bearing fruit in every good work, growing in the knowledge of God, being strengthened with all power according to his glorious might so that you may have great endurance and patience.

Thursday 24th May

Pray for the release of grace to bring the Church to abound in love

1 Thessalonians 3:12 May the Lord make your love increase and overflow for each other and for everyone else, just as ours does for you.

Friday 25th May

Pray to be worthy (made spiritually mature) to walk in the fullness of our destiny in God

2 Thessalonians 1:11-12that our God may make you worthy of his calling, and that by his power he may bring to fruition your every desire for goodness and your every deed prompted by faith. We pray this so that the name of our Lord Jesus may be glorified in you, and you in him, according to the grace of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ.

Saturday 26th May

Pray that the Word will increase its influence (effectiveness) in the town as God releases His power on it

2 Thessalonians 3:1-3 ...pray for us that the message of the Lord may spread rapidly and be honoured, just as it was with you. And pray that we may be delivered from wicked and evil people, for not everyone has faith. But the Lord is faithful, and he will strengthen you and protect you from the evil one.

Sunday 27th May

Pray for impartation of boldness (singing and speaking the Word) by releasing healing, signs, and wonders.

Acts 4:29-31 "Now, Lord, consider their threats and enable your servants to speak your word with great boldness. Stretch out your hand to heal and perform signs and wonders through the name of your holy servant Jesus." After they prayed, the place where they were meeting was shaken. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and spoke the word of God boldly.

Week 2 28th May – 3rd June: Praying for our communities

Monday 28th May

Pray for the Council and those in authority that we would have favour and they would be blessed

1 Timothy 2:1-4 I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for all people—for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness. This is good, and pleases God our Saviour, who wants all people to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth.

Tuesday 29th May

Pray for doors of opportunity to open to invite members of our communities to HOPE 18.

Colossians 4:3-6 ...pray for us, too, that God may open a door for our message, so that we may proclaim the mystery of Christ, for which I am in chains. Pray that I may proclaim it clearly, as I should. Be wise in the way you act toward outsiders; make the most of every opportunity. Let your conversation be always full of grace, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how to answer everyone.

Wednesday 30th May

Pray that God would remove any obstacles to HOPE18

Isaiah 57:14 "Build up, build up, prepare the road! Remove the obstacles out of the way of my people."

Thursday 31st May

Pray for your friends and neighbours

Acts 26: 16-18 *I have appeared to you to appoint you as a servant and as a witness of what you have seen and will see of me. I will rescue you from your own people and from the Gentiles. I am sending you to them to open their eyes and turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan to God, so that they may receive forgiveness of sins and a place among those who are sanctified by faith in me.*

Friday 1st June

Pray for the children and young people in our community

Ephesians 3:16-19 *I pray that out of his glorious riches he may strengthen you with power through his Spirit in your inner being, so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith. And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, may have power, together with all the Lord's holy people, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, and to know this love that surpasses knowledge—that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God.*

Saturday 2nd June

Pray that our town would be blessed by HOPE18

Proverbs 11:10-11 *When the righteous prosper, the city rejoices; when the wicked perish, there are shouts of joy. Through the blessing of the upright a city is exalted but by the mouth of the wicked it is destroyed.*

Sunday 3rd June

Pray that God would turn many hearts to Him.

Luke 1:17 *"And he will go on before the Lord, in the spirit and power of Elijah, to turn the hearts of the parents to their children and the disobedient to the wisdom of the righteous—to make ready a people prepared for the Lord."*

Week 3 4th – 10th June: Praying for the team from Moorlands

Pray the following verses for each individual student (see next page)

2 Thessalonians 1:11-12

...that our God may make you worthy of his calling, and that by his power he may bring to fruition your every desire for goodness and your every deed prompted by faith. We pray this so that the name of our Lord Jesus may be glorified in you, and you in him, according to the grace of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ.

Colossians 2:2-3

My goal is that they may be encouraged in heart and united in love, so that they may have the full riches of complete understanding, in order that they may know the mystery of God, namely, Christ, in whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge.

Week 4 11th – 17th June: Praying for the HOPE18 weekend

Monday 11th June

Pray for good weather for the whole weekend

Psalm 135: 5-7 *I know that the Lord is great, that our Lord is greater than all gods. The Lord does whatever pleases him, in the heavens and on the earth, in the seas and all their depths. He makes clouds rise from the ends of the earth; he sends lightning with the rain and brings out the wind from his storehouses.*

Tuesday 12th June

Pray for protection and safety on the streets and the recreation ground

Nahum 1:7 *The Lord is good, a refuge in times of trouble. He cares for those who trust in him.*

Wednesday 13th June

Pray for Daughters of Davis and Steve Lee as they prepare to join us

John 15:16 *You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you so that you might go and bear fruit—fruit that will last—and so that whatever you ask in my name the Father will give you.*

Thursday 14th June

Pray for church leaders as they welcome the team and make final arrangements

Proverbs 3:5-6 *Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight.*

Friday 15th June

Pray for the teams as they go out prayer walking

Joshua 1:3,5,6 *I will give you every place where you set your foot... I will be with you; I will never leave you nor forsake you. Be strong and courageous, because you will lead these people to inherit the land I swore to their ancestors to give them.*

Saturday 16th June

Pray that New Milton will be filled with the presence of the Holy Spirit

Acts 10:44-45 *While Peter was still speaking these words, the Holy Spirit came on all who heard the message. The circumcised believers who had come with Peter were astonished that the gift of the Holy Spirit had been poured out even on Gentiles.*

Sunday 17th June

Pray for the harvest to come in

Psalm 85:10-12 *Love and faithfulness meet together; righteousness and peace kiss each other. Faithfulness springs forth from the earth, and righteousness looks down from heaven. The Lord will indeed give what is good, and our land will yield its harvest.*
